American Civil Liberties Union (ACLU): Will be awarded to 15 students across the US that have a passion for civil liberties. November deadline

American Legion offers the Charles Barber Scholarship, the Ray Greenwood Scholarship and other scholarships. The senior must be a US citizen, accepted at an approved/accredited school or college. April deadline

American Mensa – essay explaining career, academic and/or vocational goals. January deadline.

Amy Bindelgrass Memorial Scholarship was established to enhance awareness of organ and tissue donation. Essay contest. April Deadline

Delano Nulty Scholarships from the Lyric Theatre Company. Offer is for students involved in theatre. May deadline

Gardner Manosh Scholarship Fund for those pursuing a career in law enforcement or government service. March deadline

Green Mountain Fraternal Order of Eagles offers the Robbie Pollander and the Edison A. Reynolds to high school graduating seniors from Lamoille County. The submission of a biography and the submission of a theme based essay. May Deadline

May deadline

Lamoille Region Chamber of Commerce: Must be an employee or child of an employee of a LRCC member, live in Lamoille County, attending vocational/2 year/4 year college, GPA 2.4 (80) or better. May deadline

League of Women Voters Winona Smith Scholarship goes to someone who has demonstrated an interest in civic participation and community service. April Deadline

NAEOP Marion T. Wood Student Scholarship for MAEOP affiliates pursuing a career in an office related business program. May deadline

Members Advantage Community Credit Union has the Francis Henry Memorial Scholarship for credit union members with academic excellence, extracurricular activities, community service and financial need. May deadline

N.E. Federal Credit Union Nursing Scholarship: Must be a member of the credit union and applying (carry 6 credits) to college/trade school/university. February deadline

N.E. Federal Credit Union Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics (S.T.E.M.) Scholarship Program for members entering a field of study in one of these disciplines. April deadline

United Motorcyclists of Vermont: Seniors entering a technical/2year/4 year college. March deadline

University Mall Scholarship of Excellence to recognize seniors who have demonstrated excellence in community service, leadership and academics. April deadline

VF W Ladies Auxiliary – girls related to a VF W member furthering their education. April deadline

Vietnam Veterans of America offers the Michael Lawton College Scholarship Grant and the Lyndon F. Murray Sr. College Scholarship. April deadline

Vermont Federal Credit Union: Be a member of the credit union, graduating high school senior, and GPA 2.5 or better (80). April deadline

Golf Association: Top 40% of class, Vermont resident, GPA 80 or better and minimum combined SAT score of 1000. April deadline

Vermont Grocer's Association Scholarship: Be a dependent/employee (minimum 15 hours weekly/750 yearly) of a VGA retail store. April deadline

Vermont JCI Senate Scholarship: High school senior, furthering education, financial need. January deadline

Vermont NEA offers the Maida F. Townsend Scholarship to a high school senior furthering his/her education, priority may be given to education major, based on merit not financial need. February deadline

Vermont Superintendents Association Alice Angney Scholarship for Leadership and Service March deadline '

VT State Labor Council James Cross Scholarship – parent/guardian member of AFL-CIO; essay exam dealing with current events. Early April deadline

Vermont Technical College Scholars Program for students attending VT Tech who have demonstrated their potential for academic and personal achievement. April deadline
